Independence Day, celebrated on July 4th, commemorates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence in 1776, marking the United States' separation from British rule. In 1852, abolitionist Frederick Douglass delivered his famous speech, "What to the Slave is the Fourth of July?" He highlighted the hypocrisy of a nation celebrating freedom while perpetuating slavery, calling for genuine liberty and equality for all. At the time of the Declaration of Independence, Black people in America were predominantly enslaved and denied the freedoms and rights proclaimed in the document. The relationship between Independence Day and Black Americans is complex, reflecting a history of struggle, resilience, and evolving recognition of freedom and equality.
